

## 2018 NCGA Senior Four Ball Qualifier Los Lagos Golf Course - May 19th, 2018

Welcome to our club qualifier for the NCGA Senior Four Ball Net Championship. The event is actually two events in one. For the NCGA qualifier, we will send the top two teams on to the next round of the competition on August 8 at a local course. Winners there will advance to the finals on September 10 and 11 at Poppy Ridge in Livermore. To compete in this part of the event, you must be 55 by April 4, 2018 and available to play in the subsequent rounds scheduled by the NCGA. All subsequent rounds will be paid for by the players.

For the NCGA qualifier, the maximum index is 18.4. As usual for NCGA 4-ball events, players play at 90% of their course handicap. In the competition for prizes and TOC points there is no maximum index. As a result, some teams will have 2 scorecards. USGA rule 3-5 was used to adjust the course handicap, allowing two flights to play from different tees equitably for the qualifier portion of the tournament.

Turn in your scorecards to Chuck Pickett at the end of the round.

In the event of a tie for the qualifier portion of the tournament, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff to determine the winners.

Carts are included in the entry fee. We will adhere to USGA rules, Los Lagos Golf Course rules, and PAGC local rules.

For the club tournament, there will be two flights. The first flight will play from the [blue](#) Tees. The second flight will play from the white tees. Pay attention if you are in a group playing from different tees. The payouts for each flight are \$35 low gross and low net, \$20 second low net, and \$13 third low net, all on the books at Baylands.

Our next tournament is at Santa Teresa. Signups for Santa Teresa close on May 26, so please sign up early.
